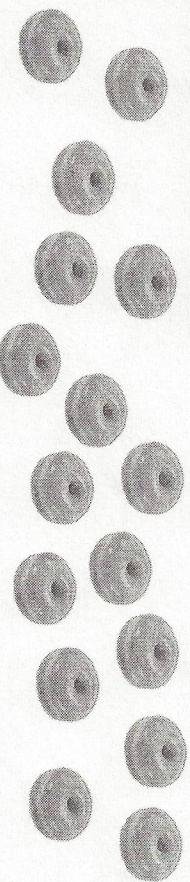


# The differences between Communism and Capitalism

## Communism

- Everyone is the same (no more rich, middle class & poor). We are all workers.
- No more private ownership - everyone works for the collective good.
- One-party government run by the workers.

## Capitalism
