

Photovoice Assignment #2 – 10%

You will use the medium of photography to create a piece of evidence or a symbolic representation around a theme to offer insight, teach others about your experiences, and to help other see the world through your eyes.

Take and select 3 photos that reflect one of the following themes. The photos should explore the themes from a mainstream perspective, an Indigenous perspective, or could highlight a dialogue/relationship between the two world views.

- Community
- Identity
- Family & friends
- Relationships to the land
- Creation
- Traditions
- Government/Authority
- Learning
- Food
- Environment
- Indigenous ways of knowing and doing
- Other theme of your choice (outline theme in your description)

Each photo will be titled. You will then create a voiceover or a written caption to each of the three photos. This information can be shared through a word document, weebly, prezzi, or by attached file to an email. Descriptions can also be delivered verbally, either to the class or individually to the instructors. The descriptions will answer the following items:

- 1) A description of what/who is in the photo
- 2) What is happening in the photo?
- 3) How does this relate to the chosen theme(s)?
- 4) Does this speak to the mental, spiritual, physical, or emotional state, or a combination of them?

Assignment Checklist

- 3 photos
- Title for each photo
- Written/audio description of the photo
- Answer to all of the 4 questions above
