

Monument Stone Committee Brief
March 4th, 2024

Responsibilities:

- This project must honour the overall vision behind the creation of the <u>Souharissen</u> Natural Area.
- Learn about the Silver Covenant Chain of Friendship and how it is threaded into these lands.
- The name "Souharrisen Natural Area" must be displayed on the stone, as well as the name given to "The Ponds Area"
 - The name for the area needs to honour the Neutral Nation and needs to be determined by working with Rick Hill
- The stone should provide a teaching to Waterdown/Flamborough residents about the Treaties they are part of, information about the ponds (work with the Pond Committee) and the art installation (work with the artwork committee).
- The final design, including text, must be approved by the Ogiima Kwe and Council of the Mississaugas of the Credit. (Consult the original Monument Stone created for Souharissen Natural Area, as well as template included with this brief).

*A successful application was made to the Flamborough Community Council to cover the cost of this monument stone (\$4000.00).

Questions to answer:

What treaties are part of this land?

What specific article[s] of the *United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples* does your committee's work fall under?

What teachings does Elder Garry want included?

What teachings does Rick Hill have for you regarding a name for the space?

*With Mr. Tidridge's help this committee will need to reach out to Elder Garry Sault and Rick Hill to seek his advice on this project.


