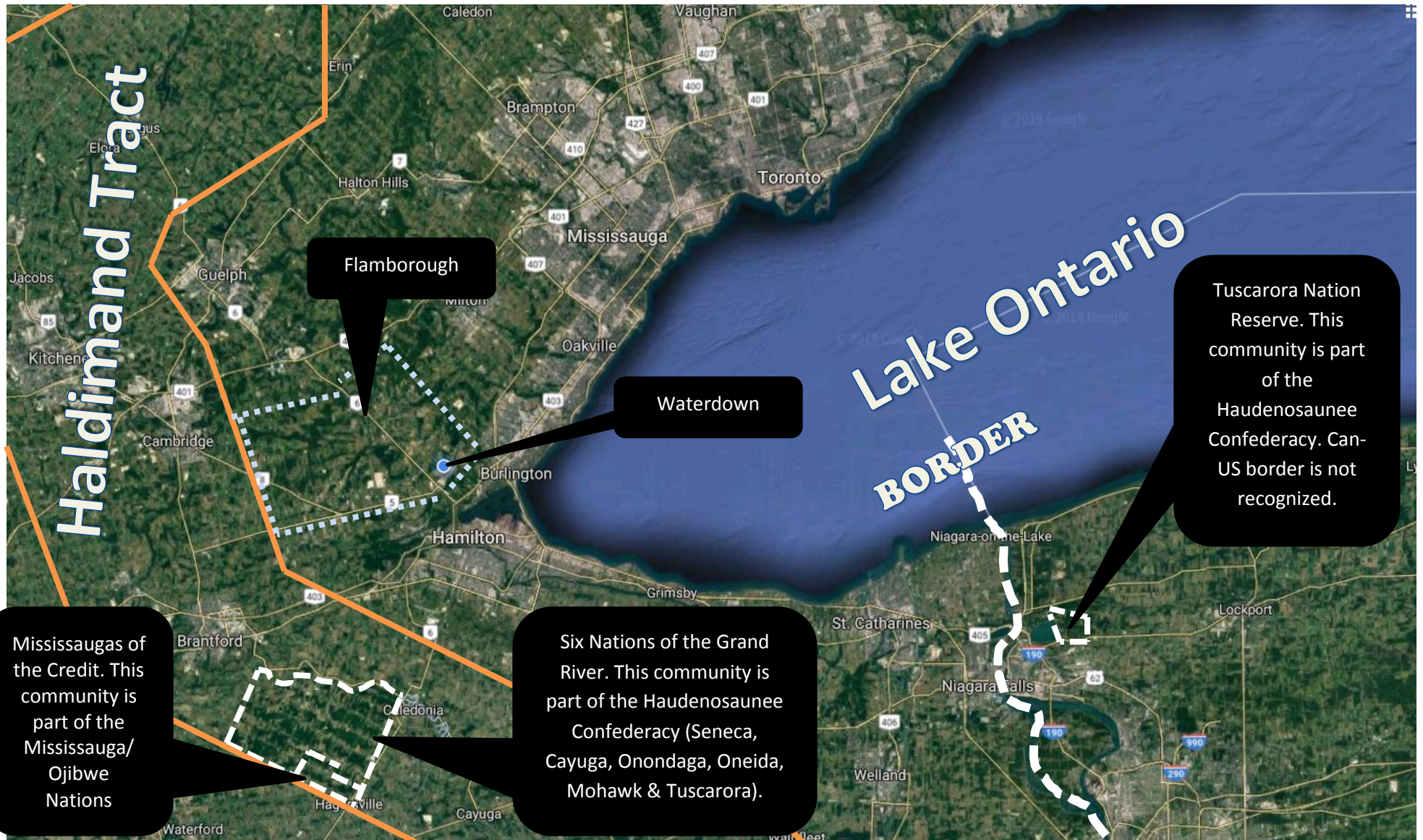


Indigenous Reserves near Waterdown/Flamborough



Things to keep in mind: In Canada, most reserves are held by the Crown in trust for Indigenous Peoples (these means they are administered, and funded, by the Federal Government through the Indian Act). Reserves may be located in a nation's territory, but they do not represent "all that is left of that nation." Most Indigenous People in Canada do not live on reserves. A nation can, and is often, spread out over numerous reserves. Many nations do not recognize the Canada-US border.
