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It was then that my internal monologue began to think about how to navigate this situation...in my head I'm thinking "I can't wear this, this is messed up" also thinking "how can I say I don't wanna wear this, being the new guy to the team in a room of all white males..???"

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As I looked around the dressing room I thought to myself, perhaps after building some relationships with a few of them I can broach the conversation....but until then every week I slide this jersey on that I unknowingly paid for as part of my fees.
