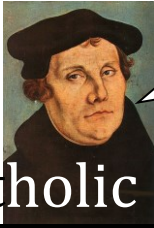


The Reformation Period

Humanism



My name is Martin Luther. In 1517, I advocated reforming the Catholic Church – ridding it of corruption.

The Catholic Church undergoes its own Reformation, infused with Humanist ideas, reexamining its institutions. A heavy value is placed on education.

King Henry VIII of England replaces the pope as Head of the Church in England. To Henry, the Church of England is still Catholic, only without papal control from Rome.

After the death of Henry VIII, the English Church becomes more “Protestant,” rejecting many Roamn Catholic teachings.

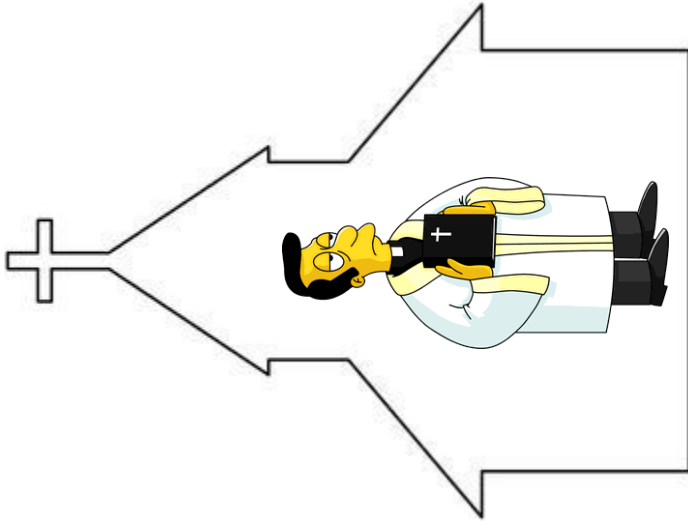
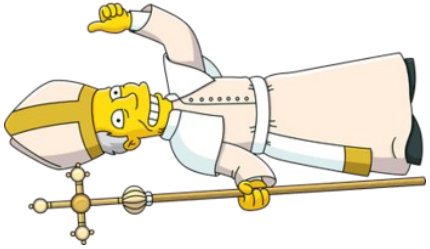
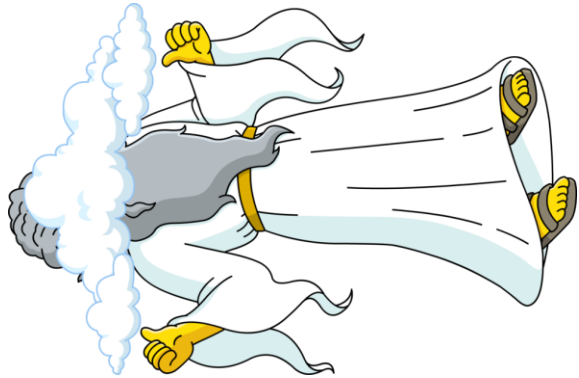
King Henry VIII denounces Martin Luther and is awarded the title “Defender of the Faith” by the pope. Ironic . . .
