The **Co-operative Commonwealth Federation (CCF)** was founded in 1932 in Calgary, Alberta, by a number of socialist, agrarian, co-operative, and labour groups and the League for Social Reconstruction. In 1944, the CCF formed the first social-democratic government in North America when it was elected to form the provincial government in Saskatchewan. In 1961, the CCF was succeeded by the New Democratic Party (NDP).
